Disaster (Webster's Online)

- : something (such as a flood, tornado, fire, plane crash, etc.) that happens suddenly and causes much suffering or loss to many people
- : something that has a very bad effect or result
- : a complete or terrible failure

Marriage Disasters - PV

- Anything that alters the perceived Identity of the marriage, family or one of the spouses in a manner that one or both spouses perceives as disastrous or irrecoverable.
- Disasters predict divorce with 8o 90% probability

90% Divorce

- Adultery
- Death of a Child
- Gastric Bypass Surgery

Disasters with Variable Divorce Rates

- Abuse
- Addiction
- Theft
- Illegal activity resulting in incarceration
- Poverty
- Radical changes in values and behavior (ID change)
- War and acts of Terrorism (stats from 911 and Oklahoma City)

Disaster (marriage insert)

- : something (such as a discovery of adultery/addiction/ theft/deception or death or extreme stress including war and terrorism) that happens suddenly and causes much suffering or loss to the marriage
- : something that has a very bad effect or result (gastric bypass surgery)
- : a complete or terrible failure (neglect, loss of Identity

Disaster for Van Valins

- Adultery
- Divorce
- Midlife Crisis for a 29 year old
- Who am I? Who is going to love me? What am I going to do with myself?
- 6 hours a day counseling and encouraging
- 2 to 3 x a week contact for a year

God Redeems Disasters

Factors Affecting Divorce Rates

- Isolation/Lack of Community
- Friends and Family Encourage Divorce
- New Love Interests Adultery and Child Birth
- Economic Capacity to Live Apart
- Reduced Shame due to Anonymity
- U.S. culture expects divorce
- Hedonism It is unacceptable to feel bad

Happiness/Well Being

- Positive Emotion
- Engagement of the Mind
- Relationships
- Meaning
- Achievement
- Hedonism does not lead to happiness
- Addiction = P,E,R but harms M and A

Marriage Counseling Success

- Certificate of Divorce is a Marriage Death
 Certificate
- Meta analysis of secular marriage counseling yields 10% of couples improve
- VanValins see over 90% improvement

Factors in Counseling

- 10% attitude of counselee
- 15% quality of relationship with counselor
- 25% skill of counselor
- 50% impacted by life events and other relationships and acts of God

Recovery in 12 months

- Discovery
- Get Help: Friends, Family, Pastor, Book, Counseling
- Forgiveness: You deserve death but I will not harm you.
- Autopsy of the marriage
- New boundaries, goals and habits
- Renewed commitment
- Health community

Eden Method

- 1. Increase Positive and Decrease Negative
- 2. Fix a few things
- 3. Improve communication
- 4. Restructure to improve: Time, Attention, Touch
- 5. Confession, Forgiveness and Reconciliation
- 6. Dismantle Landmines

Eden Tools

- Romance Builders, Anger Expression Scale with Time Outs, Prayers
- 2. Brainstorming for Problems
- 3. E.V.E. in emotional and rational contexts, nonjudgmental stance
- 4. Distraction Reduction
- 5. Five-Point Confession with Recovery Plan
- 6. SEARCH for Safety and Safety Days Training
